### 1. Community Engagement

- We want to work with people who use our services to help us make decisions
- We want to work together to co-produce accessible policies and plans
- We want better links with local communities



## 2. Promotion of the Mental Capacity Act and how it can be used

- We want people to understand the law about mental capacity
- We want people know how to respond if they think someone might need a mental capacity assessment
- We want practitioners to feel confident in applying the Mental Capacity Act

**Mental capacity**-means the ability to understand information, to then make and communicate decisions about your life



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## 3. Role of the Somerset Safeguarding Adults Board

- We want organisations to understand the role of the board and how it keeps adults safe
- We want all our information to be accessible
- We want to work more with organisations about keeping people safe in local communities



### 4. Safeguarding for young people becoming adults

 We want to recognise young people's needs do not change or stop when they become adults at 18 years old

Some young people are at risk of **exploitation** - this means controlled by another person and forced to do things they do not want to.

- We want to support all these young adults
- We want children's and adult services to work together
- We want a partnership to support safeguarding where young people becoming adults are more at risk
