

Annual Report Summary: 2018/19



555,195 people live in Somerset

The most common location where people were identified as being at risk was their own home (38%)



We didn't publish any Safeguarding Adult Reviews this year

The Somerset Safeguarding Adults Board (SSAB) became statutory in 2015 under the Care Act (2014)

One of the responsibilities of the SSAB is to undertake Safeguarding Adult Reviews



125,000 are aged 65 and over



Mental Capacity Act 2005

In 561 cases the adult at risk was assessed as lacking capacity to make decisions related to the safeguarding enquiry





We followed up on the recommendations of the Mendip House Safeguarding Adults Review, published in February 2018

3198 safeguarding concerns were raised with Somerset County Council



The majority of people (95%), or their representative, were asked what their desired outcomes were



We published new on-line Guidance for Safequarding Adults In Somerset for anyone to use

The SSAB has three statutory partners that the Care Act (2014) says must be members:

- Somerset County Council
- NHS Somerset Clinical Commissioning Group
- Avon & Somerset Constabulary





This led to 1148 safeguarding enquiries under Section 42 of the Care Act (2014)



In 99% of cases where desired outcomes were stated they were either partially of fully achieved



We introduced a new peer challenge element to our annual self-audit process and Healthwatch Somerset reviewed feedback processes

The majority of people that required an enquiry under Section 42 of the Care Act (2014) were female



In 97% of cases the risk was removed or reduced.



We saw significant growth in people using our website, and engaging with us using social media

Other key organisations that work with adults in Somerset also have a representative on the SSAB.

The most common risk type was Neglect and Acts of Omission which accounted for 33% of risks



As of March 2019, 92.5% of Somerset's regulated settings were good or better, in comparison to 83.5% nationally
